In that capacity she is a member of the Boards of Zonta International and the Zonta International Foundation for the 2012–2014 biennium. From 2010–2012 she served as Governor of District 15 which consists of 40 clubs in Michigan and part of Ontario, Canada. Prior to that time she was a Lt. Governor and Area Director.

It rewards the important role played by civil society and by the associations in this field. A further step toward the total overcoming of gender differences that we all hope for.

On behalf of the Regional Council of Aosta Valley, I have great pleasure in welcoming you to our region. It's a privilege to host the Zonta District Conference 2013 from 20<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> September: for three days Saint-Vincent will be transformed into a laboratory of ideas and experiences in which women will become the protagonist. Aosta Valley is a small alpine valley located in north-western Italy which shares its borders with France and Switzerland. With an area of 3,263 square kilometres and a population of 123,978 inhabitants, it is the smallest region in Italy.

Thanks to its geographical location and its unique configuration, Aosta Valley has always been an important communication crossroads between the Mediterranean and Northern Europe. Over the centuries, commercial and cultural exchanges have led to the use of a rich variety of languages and dialects that have reinforced a strong sense of independence throughout the local community. The region obtained Special Autonomy in 1948, founded on global French-Italian bilinguism, and which set it apart from other regions and take form in a greater amplitude of legislative powers and decision-making by the representative bodies in matters of particular importance for the region.

From a natural point of view, Aosta Valley embedded the highest mountains of the Alps: Mont-Blanc, Matterhorn, Monte Rosa, Grand Paradis. In this monumental landscape there are many traces of human history: here there are the remains of Neolithic settlements, works of Imperial Roman architecture, aristocratic castles and fortifications. We hope that you will have the opportunity to discover them.

I am sure that the prestigious and committed Zonta Club Aosta is working hard to offer you a wonderful welcome; from our point of view we are looking forward to seeing you. Paraphrasing your motto "The time is now", I would like to add "The time is now in Aosta Valley"!

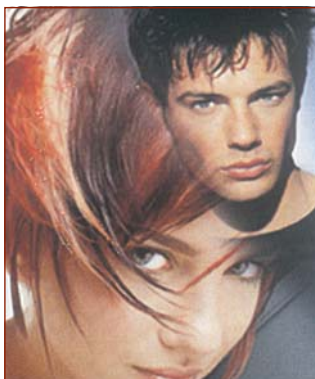

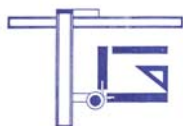

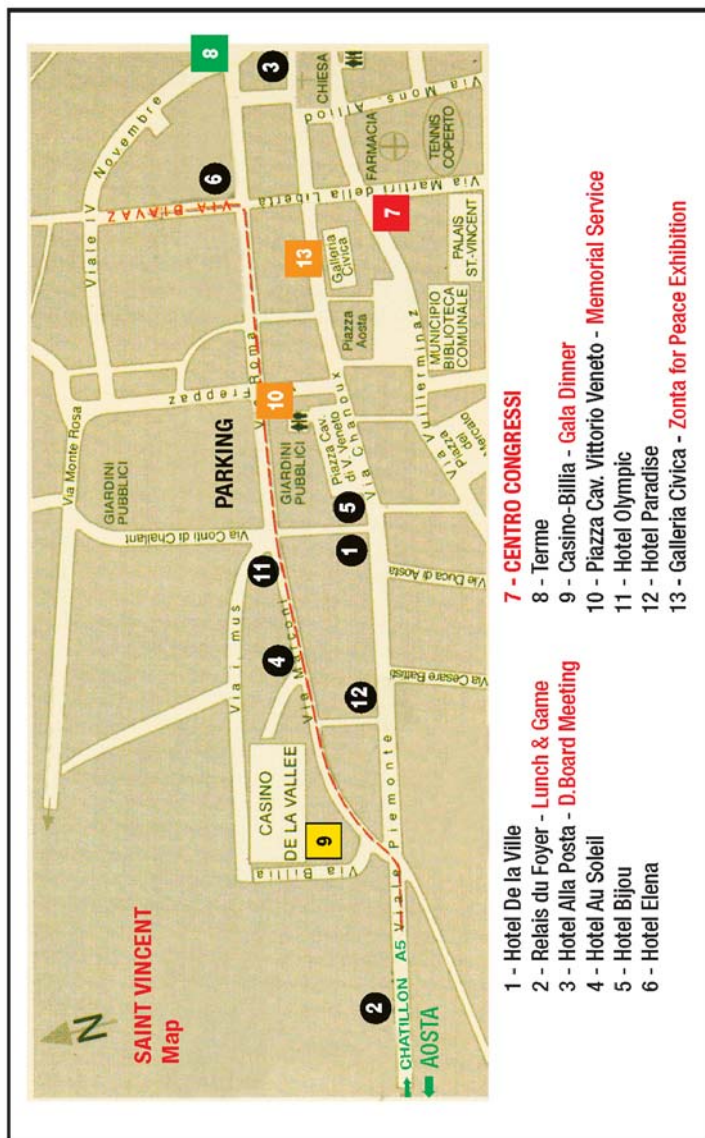
